*Apologize*

Father God, we the stake holders in the Frayser community apologize for the murder, bloodshed, violence, assault, simple assault, felony assault, larceny, petty larceny, grand larceny, adultery, fornication, debauchery, lasciviousness, witchcraft, divination, voodoo, poor judgment, errors, omissions, oversight, and mistakes of present and past generations that have made Frayser a challenging place to live, to work, and to worship. We repent for not keeping your statutes as individuals and as a community. Today, we make a conscious decision to turn away from the sin, transgression, poor judgment, error, omission, oversight, and mistakes of the past. We decide today to walk in righteousness, to walk in holiness, and to keep the statutes of the Lord. We individually and corporately renounce all guilt, shame, condemnation, and dishonor associated with our own sins, and those of the former generations. We place the memory and residue of past sin and transgression under the blood of Jesus. We forgive those who have hurt us and our community in the past, and we also forgive ourselves. We denounce a victim mentality personally and corporately, and will no longer accept the role of the victim. We accept the redemptive power of the blood of Jesus to redeem us, cover us, sanctify us, and make us whole. We commit to living our lives and to conducting our businesses in a way that is consistent with the Bible. We choose the Biblical standard of the Ten Commandments as a guide to correct moral living:

1. We shall not have any other gods except the God of Israel.
2. We shall not make idols or serve them.
3. We shall not take the Lord's name in vain.
4. We shall remember the Sabbath day and keep it holy.
5. We shall honor our mothers and fathers.
6. We shall not kill.
7. We shall not commit adultery.
8. We shall not steal.
9. We shall not bear false witness.
10. We shall not desire what is our neighbor's.

*Agree*

We the stakeholders in the Frayser community agree that Jesus is Lord and that Jesus is Lord over the USA, the State of Tennessee, the City of Memphis and the community of Frayser. We the stakeholders in the Frayser community agree that Frayser belongs to God. We agree that the power of God, along with diligent work, is necessary to transform the Frayser community from where it is today to where God has purposed it to be. We acknowledge God as the head of our community; we welcome His presence, and believe that in seeking the face of God to transform Frayser, we will see the hand of God move to help us to transform Frayser into a better place to live, work, and worship. We agree to operate in love towards all: We Love God, We Love Ourselves, and We Love Each other.

### *Decree*

We decree and declare Frayser to be a safe, well kept, decent, and desirable place to live, to work, and to worship. Further, we decree and declare in the sight of God and our fellow man the following:

#### **Bloodshed & Violence Declaration**

Father, we come before you today acknowledging you as the Most High God. We lift you and your name up above the community of Frayser. As we've confessed the crime and sins of murder, assault, violence, and bloodshed upon the land in Frayser, we acknowledge that the blood of many victims cries out from the ground in Frayser. We declare the violence and bloodshed of the past as sin and set our hearts to depart from the ways of violence. We appropriate the fully redemptive power of the blood of Jesus to cover the bloodshed and violence and to heal the people and the land from the negative effects of bloodshed. We decree and declare that the spirit of death and spirit of murder are subject to the name of Jesus in Frayser. We declare that the streets, homes, churches, and businesses in Frayser are safe to occupy. We decree and declare that spirits of fear, terror, and lawlessness no longer reign over Frayser. We release the joy of the Lord and the peace of God which surpass all human understanding over the Frayser community. We declare that we no longer lead in any statistic relating to murder, assault, violence, or bloodshed in the name of Jesus. Amen.

#### **Property Crime Declaration**

Father, we come boldly before you thanking and praising you for your blessings in the Frayser Community and we ask you to release your angels to guard us and to protect us. We use our faith, believing that thousands in our community would have the opportunity to make Jesus as their Lord and Savior.

Lord your words says when we decree a thing it shall be established, therefore we decree and declare according to your word that all the property in the Frayser Community is covered by the blood of Jesus and blessed; and that we are able to possess all that you have made available for us. We decree and declare that we are free from crime, theft, foreclosures, vandalism, drug trafficking, drug abuse, drunkenness, death, murder, depression, prostitution, sickness, poverty, lack, debt, greed, divorce and abuse. We declare that the fruit of our grounds is blessed and that the Lord delights in our prosperity and give us the power to get wealth that he may establish His covenant upon the earth.

We decree and declare that our community is washed, sanctified, made holy through the Blood of Jesus and that no weapon formed against the Frayser Community shall be able to prosper. We thank you God that your Grace, healing, and deliverance is upon all property in the Frayser Community and the entire City of Memphis. We decree and declare that the Lord shall open unto the Frayser community his good treasure, the Heavens, to give the rain to Frayser in its season and to bless all the works of our hands in Frayser; we shall lend unto many nations and not borrow. We thank you Lord that you would destroy all the works of the enemy that would try to come against our properties, homes, businesses,

churches, ministries, non-profit organizations, schools, finances marriages, children and future generations.

We thank you, Lord that you would establish your plan's, peace, love, joy, prosperity, goodness and mercy in the Frayser Community and make it a praise in the earth for your name's sake and that your will would be done in the earth as it is in heaven in Frayser.

In the name of Jesus we pray AMEN!

### **Financial Declaration**

We have acknowledged before you Heavenly Father, that we have committed great acts against the land of your beloved Frayser. These acts have caused great financial suffering among the people of the Frayser community. You have declared in your Word; 2 Chronicles 7:14: "If your people, who are called by your name, shall humble themselves and pray, and seek your face, and turn from their wicked ways, that you would hear from heaven, you would forgive their sins, and you will heal their land.

Therefore, we the residents of the land in Frayser- *churches, homes, schools, political offices, businesses, law enforcement organizations, non-profit organizations and places of entertainment*, come before you with a heart of humility and repentance as your Word has instructed us. We decree, declare and receive your healing for our land.

People from all around the city, nation, and the world come to Frayser to have their spiritual, socio-economic, and physical needs met according to your riches in glory, because we reflect your glory. We declare your glory in this place.

We decree and declare the people of Frayser are blessed to be a blessing. Just as the land of Egypt was blessed during a time of famine, because of Joseph's Godly leadership, Frayser is a blessing to it's surrounding communities because of its leaders and residents. We are a part of the Abrahamic covenant in the Old Testament and in covenant with Jesus Christ in the New Testament with far better promises. Therefore, we walk in our covenant blessings by faith and not by sight.

We decree and declare your prosperity has made us rich and added no sorrow to our lives, because every good and perfect gift is from you. We take care of the needy therefore, your anointing rest in Frayser to destroy every yoke of bondage to poverty, so that the poor can hear the good news

**of the gospel and become transformed. When they hear and do your instructions they will be transformed from states of poverty to a place of sufficiency by your Power.**

**Forgiveness Repentance Prayer**

Father, I come confessing your word from 1 John 1:9 that promises if I confess my sins that you are faithful and just to forgive me from my own sins and to cleanse me from all unrighteousness. Today, I come confessing the sins of un-forgiveness and any resulting bitterness, rejection, and rebellion before you. You promised me that if I would forgive others of their trespasses against me, that you would forgive my trespasses. Father, I ask you to forgive me of any and all of unforgiveness and grudges that I've held and to heal me from all diseases that have come about as a result of un-forgiveness and bitterness. Lord, as I open my heart to forgive today, I lay the axe to all bitter roots that have resulted from my own un-forgiveness. I thank you in advance Lord, that as I confess un-forgiveness and bitterness before you, that you will blot out my transgressions, and will not remember my sins any longer.

Lord, I make a deliberate decision tonight to release all who have rejected me and hurt me in the past. Father, your word says in Psalm 27:10 that when my mother and father forsake me, you will take me up. I release all who have neglected me, victimized me, abused me, taken advantage of me, and hurt me; all who have not been good parents to me; my mother for not being in my life to raise me; my father for not being in my life to raise me; all who put me up for adoption; all foster parents who did not love me; all parents and grandparents who did not give me the love that I expected. Father, I ask you to forgive me for not receiving love from my spouse, children, friends, loved ones, church members, family members and other who tried to show me love; I ask you to forgive me for rejecting and hurting others as a result of not being healed from my own rejection and hurt.

Lord, I ask you to forgive me for all rebellion that I have displayed, even in the face of rejection and hurt; I no longer choose to accept my own bad upbringing, rejection, victimization, and abuse as valid reasons to rebel against others; forgive me from rebelling against any and all parental authority; any and all societal authority; any and all religious authority; forgive me Father from rebelling against you, against Jesus, and the against the Holy Spirit.

Lord, I bring before you tonight all un-forgiveness, all bitterness, all grudges, all judgments, all strife, all feuding, all bickering, all fighting, all pettiness between me and my loved ones, friends, co-workers, and church members.
