

## Isaiah 60 Prayer for Memphis

1 Arise, shine Memphis;  
For your light has come!  
And the glory of the LORD is risen upon you.  
2 For behold, the darkness shall cover the earth,  
And deep darkness the people;  
But the LORD will arise over you, Memphis  
And His glory will be seen upon you.  
3 The Gentiles shall come to your light Memphis,  
And kings to the brightness of your rising.  
4 “ Lift up your eyes all around, and see:  
They all gather together, they come to you Memphis;  
Your sons shall come from afar,  
And your daughters shall be nursed at *your* side.  
5 Then you shall see and become radiant Memphis,  
And your heart shall swell with joy;  
Because the abundance of the sea shall be turned to you,  
The wealth of the Gentiles shall come to you Memphis.  
6 The multitude of camels shall cover your *land*,  
The dromedaries of Midian and Ephah;  
All those from Sheba shall come;  
They shall bring gold and incense,  
And they shall proclaim the praises of the LORD.  
7 All the flocks of Kedar shall be gathered together to you Memphis,  
The rams of Nebaioth shall minister to you;  
They shall ascend with acceptance on My altar,  
And I will glorify the houses of My glory, my local churches, my Dwelling Places.  
8 “ Who *are* these *who* fly like a cloud,  
And like doves to their roosts?  
9 Surely the coastlands shall wait for Me;  
And the ships of Tarshish *will come* first,  
To bring your sons from afar,  
Their silver and their gold with them,  
To the name of the LORD your God, Jehovah,  
And to the Holy One of Israel,  
Because He has glorified you.  
10 “ The sons of foreigners shall build up your walls, Memphis,  
And their kings shall minister to you;  
For in My wrath I struck you,  
But in My favor I have had mercy on you.  
11 Therefore your gates shall be open continually, Memphis;  
They shall not be shut day or night, Memphis,  
That *men* may bring to you the wealth of the Gentiles,  
And their kings in procession.  
12 For the nation and kingdom which will not serve you shall perish,

And *those* nations shall be utterly ruined.

13 “ The glory of Lebanon shall come to you,  
The cypress, the pine, and the box tree together,  
To beautify the place of My sanctuary, my local churches, my Dwelling Places;  
And I will make the place of My feet glorious.

14 Also the sons of those who afflicted you  
Shall come bowing to you,  
And all those who despised you shall fall prostrate at the soles of your feet;  
And they shall call you The City of the LORD,  
Zion of the Holy One of Israel.

15 “ Whereas you have been forsaken and hated, Memphis,  
So that no one went through *you, but tried to escape from you and go around you*  
I will make you an eternal excellence,  
A joy of many generations.

16 You shall drink the milk of the Gentiles,  
And milk the breast of kings;  
You shall know that I, the LORD, *am* your Savior  
And your Redeemer, the Mighty One of Jacob.

17 “ Instead of bronze I will bring gold,  
Instead of iron I will bring silver,  
Instead of wood, bronze,  
And instead of stones, iron.  
I will also make peace your leader,  
And righteousness your ruler.

18 Violence shall no longer be heard in your land,  
Neither wasting nor destruction within your borders;  
But Memphis, you shall call your walls Salvation And your gates Praise.

### **God the Glory of His People**

19 “ The sun shall no longer be your light by day,  
Nor for brightness shall the moon give light to you;  
But the LORD will be to you an everlasting light,  
And your God your glory.

20 Your sun shall no longer go down,  
Nor shall your moon withdraw itself;  
For the LORD will be your everlasting light, Memphis,  
And the days of your mourning shall be ended.

21 Also your people *shall all be* righteous;  
They shall inherit the land forever,  
The branch of My planting,  
The work of My hands,  
That I may be glorified.

22 A little one shall become a thousand,  
And a small one a strong nation.  
I, the LORD, will hasten it in its time.”
